Check-In and Parking Information

Parking and Unloading

- Address: Carolina Point, 19 Pinnacle Point Lane, Brevard, NC 28712
- Check-in is 2:00 PM on Thursday, October 16th.
- The first thing you must do when you arrive at camp is check in.
- We strongly encourage carpooling to avoid traffic jams during check-in.
- Parking is available in the lot behind the Sawmill (Chapel). Please do not park along roads or sidewalks so that camp and emergency vehicles can maintain access to all areas.
- Do not park directly behind the Dining Hall (Kitchen).
- Buses should unload before the dorms and continue on the loop road to depart.
- Adult Guests staying at Redmond Gap may drive their vehicles back and forth between Redmond Gap and Carolina Point as necessary. Adult Guests should park in the Sawmill Parking Area.

Check-In Instructions

1. When you reach the entrance, follow the signs and security instructions to check-in.
2. Drive your car to the check-in area and pull it to the side.
3. If your parents are dropping you off, take your luggage out and bring it to check-in. After you are checked in, you can go directly to your room.
4. If you have driven to camp, leave your luggage in the vehicle, go to our check-in desk, and get checked in.
5. Then, drive to the back of your cabin and get unloaded. Then, pull around the parking area behind Sawmill and follow directions to parking.

What You Need To Bring

- A sleeping bag or twin sheet set (pillows and blankets are provided)
- Towels and toiletries
- Bring a warm jacket
- You might want to bring extra clothes just in case.
- A good pair of comfortable shoes.
- Bring cash or a card that you can use to make purchases at the concession stand and convenience store on camp.
- Your Bible
- A notebook and pen if you would like to take notes

Who Is Allowed at the Camp

- Only registered campers and our registered volunteer staff are allowed on camp property during the day. This is a youth camp, and we want to maintain that atmosphere throughout.
- Parents and unregistered youth are NOT ALLOWED to come to camp or eat meals in the cafeteria.

- The services are for registered campers and our staff of volunteers.
- **Due to limited seating, the service is NOT open to all who wish to attend.**
- If you are a driver or a parent and wish to come to service, please contact us to see if it's possible.
- Services will be Thursday, Friday, and Saturday at 6:30 PM and Sunday at 10 am.

Flights and Shuttle Schedule

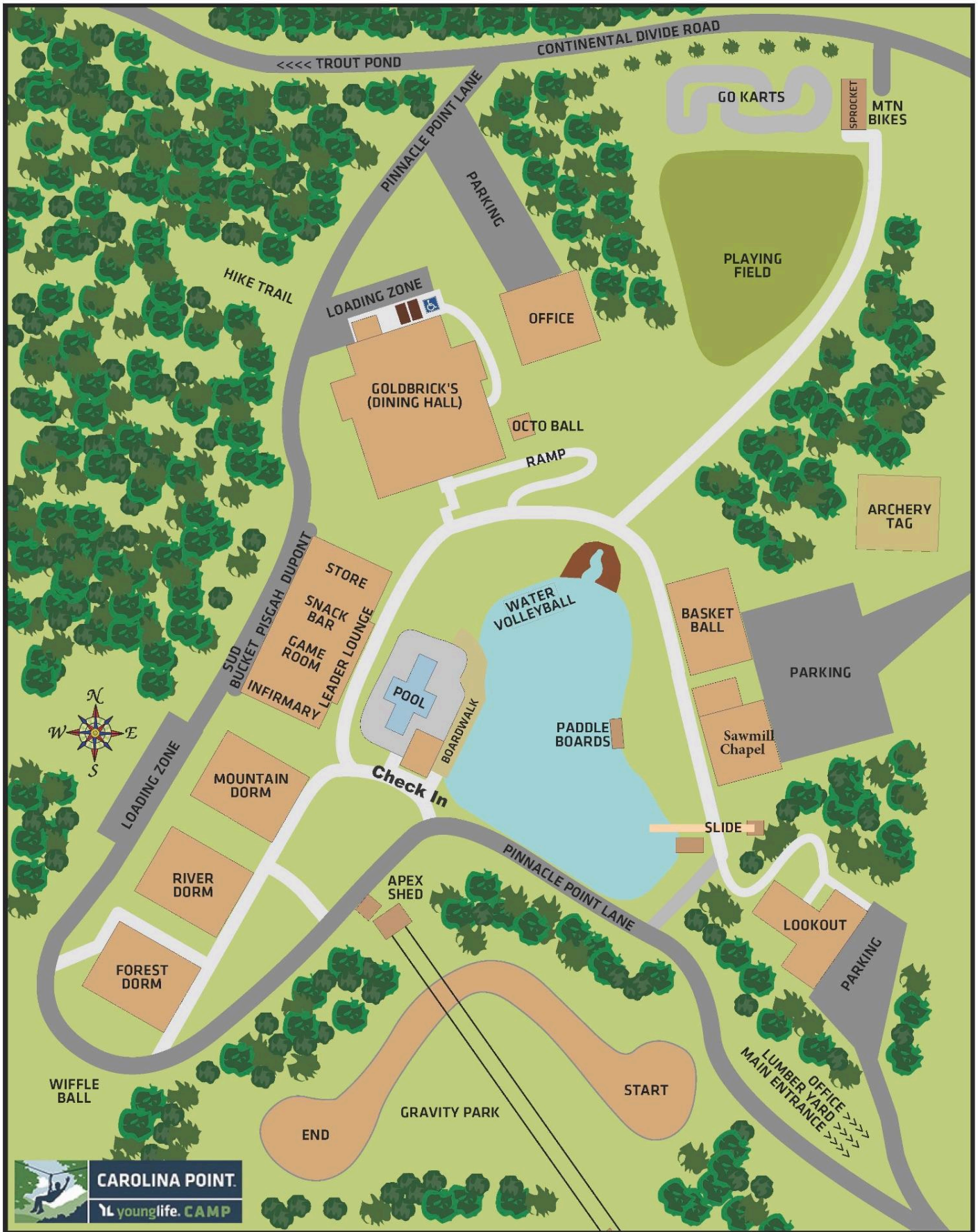

Camp Rules and Regulations

Our desire for Bethel Youth Camp is to connect with young people's hearts and see them transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit in relationships with fellow campers, counselors, and camp staff.

We operate our camp with clear expectations and clear consequences. If rules are violated, our counselor or security team lead will issue a warning. The second violation is calling your parents and having them take you home. This will be done together with our leadership team. We reserve the right to send you home from camp for any violation. They will be detailed below. Your parents expect us to provide a safe and edifying atmosphere for you.

1. Boys are not allowed in the girls' dorms, and vice versa, this can result in immediate expulsion.
2. It is not allowed to leave your cabin before rise and shine and after the lights are out, and it can result in immediate expulsion.
3. Extreme practical jokes and cabin raids are not allowed, and it can result in immediate expulsion.
4. There is no cursing, fighting, pushing, punching, bullying, or other inappropriate behavior, which could result in immediate expulsion.
5. It is not allowed to watch movies or television shows on apps in the cabins. When it is time for lights out, phones must be put away as well.
6. The hiking trails will be for organized hikes only. You may not go hiking without supervision. They are off limits to individuals and groups unless you are going with one of our organized hikes.
7. Campers are not allowed to drive any golf carts.
8. Campers are not allowed to leave the camp once they have checked in unless with prior approval. Those who have driven need to leave their cars in place once they park them.
9. All campers must attend the entire chapel services unless they are feeling unwell, in which case they need to meet with our medical staff.
10. All campers must be in their cabins after lights out.
11. No headphones or AirPods of any kind will be allowed during the day.
12. Camp directors reserve the right to send home any campers if, in their judgment they have violated camp rules, and in such cases, refunds will not be given.

Modesty

From Asheville, NC

Take **I-26 East** to **Exit 40** Hwy 280/Asheville Airport. Turn **right** onto **Hwy 280** and go about 15 miles to Brevard. Drive to downtown Brevard and turn **left** on **E. Main St.** Main St. will turn into **Hwy 276**. Follow Hwy 276 for 4.2 miles and turn **right** onto **Island Ford Road** across from Mud Dabber's Pottery. Drive 2.0 miles and turn **left** onto **Walnut Hollow Road**. Drive 4.7 miles and bear **right** onto **Glady Fork Road**. Drive 3.8 miles and turn **right** onto **Continental Divide Rd.** Enter the main gate on the left or drive $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to get to the Dining Hall parking.

From Greenville, SC

Follow directions to **Highway 11** and follow Hwy 11 to **Highway 178** (4-way stop). Turn **right** on **Hwy 178** toward Rosman. *Continued below from Hwy 11/Hwy 178 Intersection.*

From Atlanta, GA

Take **I-85** north. Cross the GA-SC line at Lake Hartwell. Take **Exit 1** Highway 11. Continue to the intersection of Hwy 11 and **Hwy 178** (4-way stop). Turn **left** on Hwy 178 toward Rosman. *Continued below from Hwy 11/Hwy 178 Intersection.*

From Charlotte, NC

Take **I-85 South** to **I-26 West**, toward Asheville. Go to **Hwy 11** toward **Table Rock**. You will cross Highway 25, pass Table Rock, and continue to **Hwy 178** (4-way stop). Turn **right** on Hwy 178 toward Rosman. *Continued below from Hwy 11/Hwy 178 Intersection.*

From Hwy 11/Hwy 178 Intersection:

Go 7.4 miles and turn **right** on **Van Clayton Rd.** Go just over three miles and turn left on the first paved road, **Glady Fork**. Go 0.2 mile and turn left onto **Continental Divide Rd.** Turn left into the Main Gate or drive $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to get to the Service Entrance/Dining Hall parking.

Free Time Activities

Rides

The following rides are available during your weekend trip. These rides are staffed by trained and certified Carolina Point Wranglers. Close-toed shoes are required for all rides.

Archery Tag—Archery Tag is a unique sport that combines elements of dodgeball or other combat-type games with the timeless skills of archery. Players aim at each other in our Archery Tag arena with a facemask, bow, and foam-tipped arrows.

Borderline Speedway—GoKarts—Rides are on a first—come, first—served basis and will run throughout free time.

There are 10 single-seat Gas Powered GoKarts & 4 2-seat Gas Powered Go Karts. Participants must wear closed-toed shoes to be able to ride this ride. Rides will last 8 minutes and then participants are welcome to return to the end of the line and go again.

Game Room

The Game Room is equipped with ping pong, shuffleboard, carpetball, foosball, and concessions.

Playing Courts

Carolina Point is equipped with a whiffle ball field and multiple basketball courts. Volleyballs and basketballs are provided. There will also be a Volleyball and Whiffle Ball tournament. Sign-ups will be available at the basketball court on Thursday afternoon.

Frisbee Golf

An 18-hole Frisbee Golf Course spans the width of the property. Frisbees are provided by CPT and are located on the porch of Main Street.

Playing Fields

The playing field is available for Ultimate Frisbee, Football, Field Games, and other activities, including Soccer Goals. Recreation Balls for these games are available at CPT upon request.

Hiking Trails

Several hiking trails are accessible from the base of Carolina Point, including a hike showing a view from the beautiful “Overlook.” There will be organized group hikes only, scheduled on each day.
